

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY

VALPARAISO, INDIANA

March 10, 2011

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana met March 10, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall. Present were members Mayor Jon Costas, Bill Oeding and Clerk-Treasurer Sharon Swihart. Mayor Costas called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Oeding moved that the minutes of the February 24, 2010 meeting be approved as presented, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved. Bill Oeding moved that the claims be approved for payment subject to appropriation balances, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved.

TRAFFIC & SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Tim Burkman presented the recommendations of the Traffic and Safety Committee for the following items:

1. Post "No Parking – Student Pickup Only" on the west side of Milton Street from Park Avenue to Grove Avenue.
2. Post the existing angled parking spaces on the west side of Morgan Boulevard, south of Lincolnway as "Compact Car Parking Only".

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

TROYER GROUP ADDENDUM

Tim Burkman requested approval of an addendum to the Troyer Group contract for the Silhavy/Vale Park Roundabout. The amount of the addendum is \$6,800.00 to be paid by the Redevelopment Commission. This will include additional landscaping, lighting design, irrigation design and additional utility coordination. Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

CITIZEN REQUESTS

1. Approval was requested for the street closure of Franklin Street on Wednesday, July 27, 2011 from 5:30pm to 8:30 pm for Concert in the Park to be held on the east side of the Courthouse.
2. Approval was requested for the Annual Via Crucis Procession being held on Good Friday, April 22, 2011, beginning at 3:30pm or so and ending at approximately 5:15pm with some help with street crossing.
3. Approval was requested for street closure on Wednesday, March 30, from 12pm-2pm for the Vietnam Veterans Day Celebration. Monroe Street from Washington to Franklin would be closed for that time.
4. Approval was requested for street closure on Saturday, May 21, 2011 from 12pm -5pm for Day of Unity on the Courthouse square. Washington from Indiana Street to Lincolnway would be closed.
5. Approval was requested for street closure for the Annual Soap Box Derby to be held on Saturday, June 18, 2011 from 6am to approximately 5pm.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

OUTDOOR DINING HOURS OF OPERATION

Craig Phillips requested the approval of the hours of operation for all activities associated with an outdoor dining facility shall cease no later than 12:00 midnight. Establishments wishing to hold a special event of longer duration shall receive approval from the Board of Works prior to the event.
