

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY

VALPARAISO, INDIANA

August 23, 2012

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana met August 23, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall. Present were Mayor Costas, Chuck Williams, Bill Oeding and Dave Hollenbeck. Mayor Costas called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Oeding moved that the minutes of the August 9, 2012 meeting be approved, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved. Bill Oeding moved that the claims be approved for payment and subject to appropriation balances, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved. Voting abstained by Chuck Williams.

Traffic and Safety

Tim Burkman moved to install a street light within the alley located south of Union Street, east of Morgan Boulevard. Remove the "Handicap Parking Only" posted on the west side of Greenwich Street south of Jefferson Street. To post a STOP sign on Glenrose Court at Monticello Park Drive.
