Traffic & Safety

Matt Evans recommended the following Traffic and Safety Recommendations

- Post the Speed Limit on McDonalds Drive as 25 MPH
- Reduce the posted Speed Limit (Currently 35 MPH) on Sturdy Road between US 30 and Lincolnway to 30 MPH
