

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY

VALPARAISO, INDIANA

February 23, 2018

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana met February 23, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall. Present were Mayor Costas, Bill Oeding, Steve Poulos and Attorney Ethan Lowe. Mayor Costas called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Oeding moved that the minutes of the February 9, 2018 meeting be approved, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved. Mayor Costas moved that the claims be approved for payment and subject to appropriation balances, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

Traffic and Safety Recommendations

Tim Burkman requested approval of the following recommendations:

1. Remove the "No Parking" restriction along the north side of Monroe Street, from Garfield Avenue to 50-ft west of University Park Avenue.
2. Install a "No Parking Here to Corner" sign on the north side of Brown St, 50-ft west of University Park Ave, and on the south side of Brown St, 50-ft east of Garfield Ave.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

Memorial Parkway and St. Clair Drive

Tim Burkman requested acceptance of Memorial Parkway and St. Clair Drive in the Lakes of Valparaiso. A Maintenance Letter of Credit has been provided in the amount of \$174,638.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

Re-Plat Pepper Cove, Phase 1

Tim Burkman requested approval of the Re-plat of Pepper Cove Phase 1. This is located at the northwest corner of Milk House Road and Froberg Road. They want 18 lots re-plated to be duplexes. Plan Commission has approved this.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

Lafayette Street Pathway

Clerk-Treasurer Swihart read bids received for the construction of the Lafayette Street Pathway:

1. Rieth Riley - \$132,855.60;
2. Walsh & Kelly - \$104,600;
3. Gariup - \$112,700;
4. Rex Construction - \$93,536.

The Engineer's office will review the bids and give a recommendation at the next meeting. The Engineer's estimate of this project is approximately \$98,000.

Citizen Requests

1. Request approval of a temporary street closure of Goodrich Road for fireworks display on Saturday July 14, 2018;
2. Request approval for Prevent Child Abuse Walk taking place on Saturday, April 21, 2018 starting at 9:30 a.m.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

Silhavy/LaPorte Roundabout

Ethan Lowe requested approval of the Agreement for the acquisition of right-of-way. These are the remaining two parcels needed for this project.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.
