

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY

**Grant Application – Valparaiso Parks Department**

Dan McGuire requested approval of a grant application for drainage work to be done at Spectacle Lake at Rogers Lakewood Park. The grant is \$30,000. The match is \$6,000. The Park Department can do \$3,000 cash and \$3,000 in-kind services.
