

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY  
VALPARAISO, INDIANA  
March 8, 2019**

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana met March 8, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall. Present were Mayor Costas, Bill Oeding and Steve Poulos. Mayor Costas called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Costas moved that the minutes of the February 22, 2019 meeting be approved, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

Mayor Costas moved that the claims be approved for payment and subject to appropriation balances, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

**Pepper Cove Phase II – Engineering Plans**

Matt Zurbriggen requested approval of the Engineering Plans for Pepper Cove Phase II.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

**2019 Community Crossings Road Improvements Project**

Nate McGinley requested approval for signatures on the contract with Reith Riley. This is subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. They will issue the Notice to Proceed in early June once school has let out for the summer.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

**Road off Silhavy adjacent to Tudor**

Mayor Costas asked Nate to look at the road adjacent to Tudor Floors off Silhavy. A citizen has reported it needs repair.

**Frost Law**

Nate McGinley requested approval to enact the Frost Law beginning March 11<sup>th</sup>. This is to coincide with the County enacting the frost law. Roads affected are listed on the web page. Permits will be issued at Public Works.

Bill Oeding moved to approve enactment of the Frost Law beginning March 11, 2019 and staying in effect until Nate McGinley determines to remove it. Seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved.

**Valparaiso Police Department Uniforms**

Chief Balon addressed the Board and reported the Department has gotten new updated uniforms. They are now an all dark color. They are getting new hats also.
