Item 1: Lincolnway & Morgan left turn for eastbound traffic

- The issue needs to be researched more
- Right now, the cabinets would not support adding a dedicated arrow system to it without rewiring it in a different way.
- There may need to be a dedicated arrow for both eastbound and westbound traffic.
- The whole bank of traffic signals and their cabinets from Campbell to Morgan will likely be upgraded in the future to the Advanced Traffic Management System (ATMS) that can be monitored right in City Hall downtown.
- The dedicated arrows should be revisited then and could be put in place at the same time as the upgrade.

Item 2: 56 West Chicago Street Residential Parking

- The parking along Chicago Street is not within the district for permit parking.
- The spot could not be given to the resident as their own spot.
- The homeowners already reached out to the church behind them about a spot.
- The solution is to replace the sidewalk in the front of them home that is in poor condition currently to allow the homeowners to be able to reach their car much easier.
- The city will need the right of way since part of the proposed sidewalk is on private property.
- Waiting to hear back from the homeowners to see if they decide to agree to replace the sidewalk.

Item 3: Banta Neighborhood Sign Toppers

- We need to know the cost of the sign toppers to determine the amount of locations we can grant them.
 - That will also depend on the length of the signs.
- Idea is to tell them a certain length that will fit all the signs appropriately and will help define costs easily.
- Also need to make sure that the sign is not the same green as city standard and non-reflective.

Homework:

- Daylilly and Silhavy Rd. Stop Sign Request
 - Take a look at the intersection and decide if it may need a stop sign or not.
- Burlington Beach Rd. and Silhavy Lines of Sight
 - Take a look at the intersection's lines of sight to see what may need to be done to improve it.
