Added items:

- Audubon street lighting issue: lighting is necessary at entrances on Silhavy Rd, service to be provided from NIPSCO, research for methodology in progress **[Engineering]**
- Yellowstone “No Trucks” sign: sign removed to solve complaints, but resident is still concerned, Board of Works (BOW) item, approval pending
- Greenwich & Monroe intersection: high crash occurrence with current intersection design (17 incidents 5yrs), evaluate options to improve intersection safety **[Engineering]**

Item 1: Sturdy Road near Villas of Vale Park speeding

- Parking issues – request “No parking” signage, BOW item, approval pending
- VPD will examine project safety results – possible radar speed signage

Item 2: Washington St Bike Lanes

- Option 2 of 3 design options was most popular
- Audit existing bike lanes, new bike lanes under consideration for future
- Item closed

Item 3: Fire Station on Indiana Avenue bollard request

- BOW item, approval pending
- Located on SW corner of building

Item 4: Michigan Street parking concern near Tower Park

- During events, parking lot fills and attendees park in front of house and stop sign. Resident should contact VPD. **[Engineering to contact resident]**
- Signage directing parking to overflow at 205 Billings Street

Item 5: Vale Park Road and Sturdy Road pedestrian crossing request

- BOW item, Public Works for striping and signage, approval pending

Item 6: Lafayette St and Harrison Blvd visibility concern - Tabled

Item 7: Calumet Avenue and Wall Street visibility concern - Tabled
