RESOLUTION SUPPORTING COMMUTER RAIL TRANSPORTATION INITIATIVE AND FUNDING OF INITIAL STUDIES FOR 2004 & 2005

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana here by agrees that the city would greatly benefit from the proposed Commuter Rail Transportation initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso supports the initiatives and efforts of Congressman Pete Visklosky and Northwest Indiana Commuter Transportation District (NICTD) to bring Commuter Rail Transportation to Valparaiso; and
